- WRCF's general lending tool
- Favorably structured small business & non-profit loans for projects ranging from \$10,000—\$500,000
- Businesses located in distressed Summit, Medina, Portage,
 Stark, and Wayne County census tracts are eligible

Minority Contractor Capital Access Program (MCCAP) ®



- Partnership between WRCF, Akron Urban League, the City of Akron and Summit County
- Favorably structured loans and technical assistance to minorityowned contracting businesses
- Businesses in Summit County are eligible

Akron Resiliency Fund



- Created by WRCF and the City of Akron
- Favorably structured small business loans from \$10,000 to \$100,000, for payroll, working capital, refinancing debt, purchasing equipment, and more
- Businesses located in distressed Akron census tracts are eligible

Summit County Affordable Housing Trust Fund



- Created by WRCF and Summit County
- Grants and loans to support non-profit orgs providing affordable housing in Summit County (construction, rehabilitation, adaptive reuse, education & more)
- Established orgs eligible inquire to learn more
